Letter of Clarifications - No. 2

1. Part A – General

We understand that cooperation with any institute, whether of Higher Education or of Vocational Training, including, a high school of the Ministry of Education, or a high school of the Ministry of Labor and Social Welfare (which also includes continuing studies programs), which meets the 4 Requirements in one or more of the Fields of Hotelier. Tourism. and/or Culinary, shall be considered as an **Institution for Higher** Education in the Fields of Tourism, Hotelier, and/or Culinary, for the purpose of Sub- section 4.6.2 (b).

The above is reinforced light of the "Amendment of the Ministerial Committee Decision, Decision No. MH7 of the **Ministerial Committee** for Privatization", dated March 31, 2015, which explicitly determines that a bidder may submit a bid in cooperation with "an Academic Institute or a Vocational Training **Institute** in the Fields of Tourism, Hotelier, and/or Culinary. Moreover, according to the criteria specified in "Table 1: Score Calculation Criteria", p. 5 of "Volume 1 -**Invitation to Bid Part** III **Evaluation** Criteria", considerable part of the allocated points are allocated for experience vocational training.

In view of all the above, please confirm that any institution, whether of Higher Education or of Vocational Training, including, a high school of the Ministry of Education or a high school of the Ministry of Labor and Social Welfare (which also includes continuing studies programs), that meets the Requirements, in one or more of the Fields of Tourism, Hotelier, and/or Culinary, shall considered be **Institution for Higher Education** in the Fields of Tourism, Hotelier, and/or Culinary, so that any bidder, which cooperates with such
